Can you help.

I have been asked to try and find out more personal details about the airmen involved in the following accident.

So far we have been unable to get any other information regarding these airmen. In fact by using the channels that are available to me in England these unfortunate airmen did not exist, apart from the information below. This appears to be true for the Australian Honour Roll as well, as they do not appear to be on it.

At 03.10 on 9th April 1945, Lancaster Bomber ND949 of 630 Squadron RAF, returning from a raid on Lutzkendorf, crashed at the village of Foxton, 3Km NW of Market Harborough, Leicestershire. All 7 crew members, 6 of whom were Australian, were killed. One of our Branch members has ascertained from the Ministry of Defense the following details about the crew and their Service Numbers.

F/Sgt Howlett - RAF Regional Cemetery, Cambridge.

Fg Off Martin - Southwick Cemetery, Sunderland.

Sgt Gibbons - Norton St Nicholas Churchyard, Letchworth, Hertfordshire.
