Insult to Injury Campaign

The Scottish Government has today announced that: "From April 2017 [the Scottish Government] will exempt from consideration in assessments of care charges War Pensions for veterans and Guaranteed Income Payments under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme for those injured after April 2005."

The Scottish Government's recent announcement thus successfully delivers on our *Insult to Injury* campaign across Great Britain, ensuring that injured veterans wherever they live, and whenever they were injured, will from April next year no longer have their compensation used to cover the costs of their social care.

Thank you to everyone who has supported this long-running campaign, and in particular our colleagues in Poppyscotland – together we've secured another landmark campaign win for our beneficiaries.
