Romsey



On the 10th November our County President, Brigadier David Harrison JP DL, attended the unveiling of a Welsh Slate Memorial Sculpture, dedicated to all those whom gave their lives in the First World War. The money was raised by members of the Romsey RBL, and the installation was



sponsored by the Great Western Railway and the volunteers of the Three Rivers Community Rail Partnership were instrumental in bringing the project to fruition.

A welcome was given by Nick Farthing the chairman of the Three Rivers Partnership and Martin Hardy of Great Western Railway spoke of the project and invited the County President to unveil the memorial. After the unveiling, the President spoke of the aftermath of the Great War and how the RBL was formed and the Poppy came into being.

After the unveiling, the stone was blessed by the Vicar of Romsey and two readings were given by pupils of Romsey School. Romsey Branch members, Martin Chandler, read the poem by John McCrae "In Flanders Field" and Steve Horsley laid the wreath. The Town Mayor of Romsey, John Parker and the Deputy Mayor of Test Valley, Carl Borg-Neal represented the civic authorities.

The memorial stone complements a series of displays at Romsey Railway Station, where young people have been researching the stories of Romsey men who gave their lives in the First World War. The stone has the iconic Poppy Motif on the monument, which has been featured at the Chelsea Flower Show.
