COUNTY CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS

My thanks go out to all of you who have supported my daughter and I during the sad time; it was a tremendous sight to see so many of you at the funeral also to the many Standard Bearers who attended many thanks.

Getting back to the business of the County I must thank my Vice Chairman Richard Graham and MSO Tony West for keeping everything on a steady footing.

In the last month I attended a branch and discussed with them how their funds are able to be spent, which as you know is very restricted. They were concerned about being able to support welfare cases directly in their area with their funds. We know this is not possible and that one of the ways to do this is to send your excess to the County Welfare Funds where we can each almonise funds to the cases from the list submitted by Head Office. In thinking about it, I have now considered that for those who would like to help directly and have the funds to do so, I have asked Tony West to breakdown the list we get of grants made to beneficiaries in Kent and send it out. Although only part of the postcode is permitted to be shown it will allow branches who still have their own excess funds to contribute to cases in their area. Cheques please to County Office made payable to Royal British Legion. The County Treasurer will co-ordinate this and send a single payment to Head Office to cover Kent.

The Membership Council is taking a strong view on Compliance of all Legion Branches and are concerned with those branches with under 15 members with a view to closing them. At its meeting on Saturday 30th April (I am writing these notes on 26th) the County Committee will have to discuss four of the branches who fall in this category with a serious view to closing them. A sad fact but one that needs doing. In a like view the MC is also looking at the MS1 Forms to ensure that each branch has at least the four main officers Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary who are all separate people - not one person doing one or more jobs. They also want to see a committee proportionate to the size of the branch being a Minimum of 3 to a maximum of 12. Please consider this strongly now in preparation for your Branch AGM so that you can elect the correct people and get the MS1 completed on time.

You will hear this month at Conference that Branch Welfare, under a new name, is to be re-launched. Therefore, whilst it is important to currently have either a Branch Welfare Committee or Representative who can direct those seeking our services to the correct area, it is also a requirement

for branches to look after comradeship within their own branch area and actively care for the lonely ex-service and branch members. Many of you have put on events etc. for years but we have not recorded numbers. Numbers and records are a requirement when dealing with local authorities and national government who live by these when we as the Legion go to seek further help for our service community. This sways them into consideration, e.g. "How many votes is it going gain or lose us if we do or don't". As soon as I get a copy of the new re-launched welfare details, I will get it sent to you.

During the month the Recruiting and Events Trailer has been at Chatham Dockyard over Easter and for St Georges Day Celebrations last Saturday in Sittingbourne High Street. At both events the public were very generous and a number of people were given either forms or details of how to join on line. Please let us know what you are doing to keep the Legion in the public eye and how successful you are.

BRANCH COMMUNITY SUPPORT

Branches may recall the Branch Welfare Project which Head Office tried to launch last year and which was subsequently withdrawn. The purpose of the Project was to try to replace the guidance on branch delivered welfare which had been put on hold at the beginning of the Pathway for Growth Programme. In conjunction with members and branches, the Operations (Welfare) Department has been working on new guidance for branch delivered welfare, which is now named 'Branch Community Support'. It will be launched at National Conference in May this year.

Branch Community Support is intended to assist branches with the provision of information, companionship and support to eligible beneficiaries within the local community in five ways:

- Support for the bereaved, including the provision of Standard Bearers at funerals
- Telephone "buddy" services
- Community awareness events
- Setting up local outreach centres

SEVENOAKS BRANCH

Vice President and D-Day veteran Patrick Moore travelled to Graye-Sur-Mer in France where he was awarded the Légion d'Honneur. Below is a cutting from the Sevenoaks Chronicle, with the paper's kind permission.

Highest honour for D-Day veteran

A D-DAY Royal Engineer veteran from Sevenoaks has been officially presented with France's highest honour in Graye-Sur-Mer.

Patrick Moore, of Wilderness Mount, who is vice-president of the area's Royal British Legion branch, travelled to one of the D-Day landing sites, opposite Juno Beach, on March 19.

The 94-year-old was presented with the Légion d'Honneur, on behalf of the President of France, for his part in the D-Day landings on June 6, 1944.

Mr Moore, who attended the ceremony with his wife Audrey, five family members and six Royal Engineers Association members, said: "I feel highly honoured. They put everything into the ceremony. "It's a Normandy medal and there's no medal like that here. I'm very grateful."

The ceremony at Chateau Vaux was attended by 180 supporters and the mayor of Graye-Sur-Mer provided a seven-course dinner for 80 in celebration of the occasion.

BATTLE OF JUTLAND COMMEMORATION

31st May 2016 marks the 100th anniversary of the Battle of Jutland, one of the largest naval actions in history. This was the most decisive sea battle of the First World War and while the Royal Navy lost more ships and suffered twice as many casualties as the German High Seas Fleet, the result was that the German fleet was contained for the remainder of the war.

To mark this centenary a number of remembrance and reconciliation events will be taking place across the UK, with the main focus of national activity being in Orkney, Scotland. There will also be a commemorative service held on the Jutland Bank with warships from both the Royal Navy and German Navy participating. A further service will take place in Belfast.

As part of this centenary there will be simultaneous commemoration services taking place at each of the naval memorials in Portsmouth, Plymouth and Chatham.

The commemoration service at Chatham will be held at the Naval Memorial, Great Lines, Gillingham **at 1430 on 31st May 2016**. It will be a static event without a parade. The service will be conducted by the Royal Navy but with participation from local representatives. It is open to all who would wish to attend. Timings for the event are as follows:

- 1400 Service Personnel and Veterans arrive.
- 1400 Organisations and general public to take position at Naval Memorial.
- 1420 VIPs arrive.
- 1430 Jutland Commemoration Service commences.
- 1505 Service completes. VIPs depart.
- 1510 Attendees disperse.
