Saturday 10th and Sunday 11th November at 7.30pm

The Hathersage Branch of the Royal British Legion are promoting this event to mark the 100th anniversary of the Armistice which ended the hostilities of the First World War

This will take the form of a presentation in words, music and images reflecting the thoughts of those who took part in the conflict and of their families at home, as well as aspects of its consequences for the community of Hathersage.

Two short one-act plays will be presented, both written by soldiers who took part in the conflict. These will be preceded and followed by a selection of poems, letters, descriptions and reflections, along with songs and music from the time, or in remembrance of it.

Exhibition – The Hathersage Connections

In conjunction with this event there will be an exhibition of images and artefacts displayed in the Stanage Hall which reflect local connections to the conflict. This exhibition will be open for public viewing on Saturday 10th (10.30am - 5.00pm) and Sunday 11th November (Mid-day - 5.00pm).

There is also to be a special tribute on display in the centre of the village from mid October commemorating the 101 people with local

connections who died in the First World War, and for those 500 or so who served in some way and survived.

The traditional Service of Remembrance will take place in the Parish Church at 10.30am on Sunday 11th November. This will be preceded by a parade from the Memorial Hall to the church in which anyone willing to do so may join. The parade will assemble 9.30am ready to set off at 10.00am
