Liphook

Colonel (Rtrd) Stuart Tootal DSO OBE, has kindly agreed to return to Liphook and talk about an elite unit of British paratroopers who were sent on a daring and highly risky behind-the-lines mission, which was deemed vital to the success of D-Day.

Dropped ahead of the main Allied invasion, 9 PARA were tasked with destroying an impregnable German gun battery. If they failed, thousands of British troops landing on the beaches were expected to die. Only twenty per cent of the unit made it to the objective and half of them were killed or wounded during the attack.

Poppy Quest Portsmouth is the perfect way to discover the past and present of this historic city. The 10km sponsored walk is suitable for all ages and abilities. You can walk solo, with your dog or with family and friends - it's completely up to you.

On setting off from the Guildhall Square, you'll be armed with a map to navigate our trail and a set of questions to answer en route which will get you to explore the city's rich history. For the kids, we'll give them a stamp collection card so when they get to each question spot, they'll be encouraged to speak to one of our volunteers to find out more and receive their stamp reward. If you're walking on your own, you can meet up with fellow solo walkers at our Meet Up point at the start. It's a great opportunity to make new friends and get your heads together to take on this unique challenge.

We're asking each adult to fundraise £50, if there are any children in your team, we've also got some fun ways for them to get involved in the fundraising. Armed Forces Day – 2019

Armed Forces Day this year falls on the 29th June, more details about the Hampshire Day will be published as soon as details released.

The IoW Armed Forces Day will take place at Newport Quay on the 22^{nd} June 2019. There will be a number of events taking place locally during the week $22^{nd} - 29^{th}$ June, so please go along and show your support.

D-Day 75 – Portsmouth - 5th – 9th June

To commemorate the 75th anniversary of the D-Day landings, a host of special events will take place across the UK and France. The Ministry of Defence has announced one of the biggest mobilisations of the UK Armed Forces in recent years, including over 4,000 personnel, 11 Royal Navy vessels and multiple aircraft, including Spitfire.

Portsmouth, where much of the landing force sailed from in 1944, will be the focal point of the UK commemorations and will host the UK national event on 5 June. Portsmouth City Council is also planning a series of events over five days to reflect the area's unique role in one of the largest and well-known military operations ever. The main commemorative event on 5 June will include a flypast of 26 RAF aircraft. Later, the city will wave off around 300 veterans, as they set sail for France, where there will be events along the Normandy beaches.

Portmouth will also host a Royal Collection Trust exhibition across the five-day commemorations, and screenings to show the events over in Normandy live. The first Portsmouth Revival Festival, celebrating the food, music, dancing and vehicles of the time, will also take place. Portsmouth's activity will culminate in a Sunset Concert for Heroes, with acts including the Military Wives Choir and the D-Day Darlings. Before sunset on the 5 June, MV Boudicca, a specially-chartered ship for 300 Normandy veterans (procured by funds from The Royal British Legion and a LIBOR grant from HM Treasury) will transport veterans across the channel to Normandy. It will be escorted by a Royal Navy vessel, representing the famous crossing 75 years before.

The ship will accommodate the veterans for the duration of their visit to Normandy and is being provided to the veterans at no cost. Any veterans that have not yet come forward are urged to get in touch with the Royal British Legion as there is still time to book a place board MV Boudicca for the journey to Normandy.

The key events will include an inauguration at the site of the Normandy Memorial Trust's British

Normandy Memorial and The Royal British Legion's services at Bayeux Cathedral and Bayeux Cemetery. The commemorations will conclude with an evening of music and entertainment beside the beaches in Arromanches. Around 2000 current serving personnel will offer support to veterans both in the UK and in France, while also taking part in the various ceremonial events.

David Williams Chief Executive Portsmouth City Council said: "The scale of D-Day 75 is unprecedented with Portsmouth at the heart of commemorations on 5 June. The city will provide the back drop for the armed forces to mark this historic occasion and, most importantly, to pay tribute to veterans and their comrades and reflect on lessons learned."
