In a previous edition we gave details of General Eisenhower being made an honorary member of the Southampton Branch in 1944. Following this the Branch received a number of offers to take the membership into safekeeping. Hampshire County Council among many were interested in placing it their archives but a week before the D-Day celebrations we received a request from Southwick House asking if they could display the membership certificate if only on a temporary basis. A couple of us were invited to visit the house at which time we were given a short tour and were pleasantly pleased and surprised to see so much memorabilia from the wartime period so well maintained and preserved.

We were shown General Eisenhower's and General Montgomery's rooms which have remained as the were with numerous photos and other items on permanent display. It was decided this would be a very apt and wonderful location to display the membership certificate on a permanent basis in what was General Eisenhower's personal

It has now been presented to Southwick House with the Branch retaining a copy. This ensures the certificate will be preserved for future generations to view and appreciate a little bit of history of the RBL. A group of us hope to be able to visit the house later in the year and see the certificate on display and enjoy a tour of the house and learn much more of its history.

Festival of Remembrance

At the last Annual Conference, Motion 4 called on us to return to the ticketing system of previous years. It has to be noted that the process applied in 2018 was brought about by new legislation out of our control, namely GDPR and the understandable need to heighten security advised by the Metropolitan Police. On behalf of Members, the Membership Council (MC) asked that the ticketing process be re-evaluated in the light of these new requirements which we have to enforce. The MC additionally requested exploring the fairness of the new system in terms of distribution of tickets to more Members and making sure we maximise the seating capacity of the Royal Albert Hall.

We are pleased to report that the 2018 ticketing process resulted in fewer empty seats at either performance than ever before. At a meeting last week, having reviewed and challenged the process and the improvements proposed for this year, the MC is content that the list of changes proposed here will solve many of the problems Members faced last year and so reduce disappointment and dissatisfaction. The MC will of course continue to review the ticketing system after this year if the issues outlined are not resolved.

Membership Ticketing

The Royal British Legion Festival of Remembrance will be held in the Royal Albert Hall, London on Saturday 9 November 2019 with performances at 2.00pm and 7.00pm.

We have amended the ticketing process and members will be able to buy tickets on a first-come-first served basis, in an exclusive Member sale, buying tickets directly from the ticket agent. Full details can be found on the attached Circular.
