2021 National Census

The next National Census is due to be completed in April 2021, and this year there is a new question specifically aimed at Serving and Retired members of HM Forces. This question is being asked so that assistance and extra funding can be targeted to the areas that have higher numbers of Serving and Retired Forces personnel. More details will be published over the next few months, but everybody is requested to fill out the Census regarding current and past service as accurately as possible.

The Town Council produced a very short service, and a number of Wreaths were laid at St Matthews Church (8th Nov) and Wreaths and Crosses for the Named from the Book of Remembrance (11th Nov).

The event was not advertised, and it was strongly recommended that people observed the 2-minute Silence on their own door steps, about 60 people who observed social distancing and majority wearing face masks, attending the Armistice Service of the 11th Nov to remember those that gave their lives in the service of their Country.

The annual Service of Remembrance was held at Petersfield War Memorial on Remembrance Sunday, 8th November, and with the Covid restrictions, the turnout was as expected a lot lower than normal, however those that did attend, followed the guide lines for social distancing and masks.


