In the great tradition of the show on the Friday the weather broke, with warnings of very high winds and torrential rains forecast overnight. This led to me and the branch Chairman having to go to the show ground to storm proof the stand. And boy did it rain!!

By dawn the rain had subsided, and the wind had dropped. Arriving at the show ground in the morning we were relieved to see that our stand had survived the night, some were not so lucky.

The aim of our stand was to celebrate RBL 100, awareness of the Legion and what we do and to raise funds for the branch. However due to the constant wind and occasional showers we were unable to display some of the information boards we had prepared.







However, despite these setbacks we had a very successful day. This was the first event in Mid Devon since lockdown and was well attended by locals and visitors to the area. Our stand was busy all day. Our teddy bear tombola stand was popular, with the Chairman and I acting as the showground barkers attracting the crowds raised a good sum for the branch funds. Over the day we also raised £1500 for the poppy appeal.

We're also very proud to be able to attach to our Standard here at the Branch the Centenary Pennant.


