1. Branch Community Support

Recently an update to the Branch Crisis Grant Policy was sent out, I have attached it to this bulletin as it is important to remember that to be able to provide a Branch Crisis Grant, the branch needs to be registered to carry out Branch Community Support (BCS). Please take time to read the document and if you are a branch not yet registered for BCS, please get in touch so we can provide you with the appropriate guidance and awareness training to register you as a BCS Branch.

2. End of Year Accounts

Branches who on the 30th June 2021 have less than £5000 in their branch bank account (Excluding BFI & CCLA), who have spent less than £500 (Excluding payments to RBL Head Office / BFI / Poppy Appeal) and have had less than £500 income (Excluding receipts from RBL Head Office / BFI) for the accounting year 2020/2021 will be eligible to complete the Branch Small Return 2021.


Heather Anguige
