
A Soldier's View – Alex Gordon Alexander:

Whilst visiting the exhibition that RBL Calne were hosting on D-Day 80, I managed to look at a book of poetry written by Alex Gordon Alexander: a member of the Calne branch.

A veteran of 26 years, Alex has written this book of poetry to help others who struggle after their service in the military with homelessness, mental health conditions and the overall transition back into civilian life.

Alex himself has struggled with Complex Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (CPTSD) for several years and has found that writing poetry helps put his feelings onto paper.

All the proceeds that are raised from the purchase of this book go towards helping other veterans who are also suffering from PTSD.
